Declaration of RoHS Conformity

In the European Union the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment is and electronic equipment is regulated by Directive 2011/65/EU. On June 4, 2015 the European Commission added four additional substances (DEHP, BBP, DBP and DIBP), which were adopted and published by Directive (EU) 2015/863. The new substances belong to the group of phthalates (plasticizers), which are classified as particularly Substances of Very High Concern. Their use in electrical and electronic equipment can have a negative impact on recycling. Furthermore, in the context of disposal, they can also have a negative impact on human health and the environment.

We, RZB Rudolf Zimmermann, Bamberg GmbH, declare that all of our products are the Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 8 June 2011 on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and Electronic Equipment and the Delegated Directive 2015/863 of the Commission amending of Annex II to Directive 2011/65/EU. Our products do not contain the following 10 designated substances not above the specified maximum concentration values by weight in homogeneous materials, unless, the substance is subject to a specified exemption.
